

## AMEN, FAITHFUL, HEBREW WORD STUDY

Faithfulness אֱמוּנָה H530 **emunah** *firmness, fidelity, steadfastness, steadiness, [faithfulness](#) (18x), [truth](#) (13x), [faithfully](#) (5x), [office](#) (5x), [faithful](#) (3x), [faith](#) (1x), [stability](#) (1x), [steady](#) (1x), [truly](#) (1x), [verily](#) (1x).* (Speaking of God and sometimes of men.)

From root: אָמַן H529 **emun**, *faithfulness, trusting* [faithful](#) (3x), [truth](#) (1x), [faith](#) (1x). (All of these are referring to men.)

From root: אָמַן H539 **aman** *to support, confirm, be faithful, [believe](#) (44x), [assurance](#) (1x), [faithful](#) (20x), [sure](#) (11x), [established](#) (7x), [trust](#) (5x), [verified](#) (3x), [stedfast](#) (2x), [continuance](#) (2x), [father](#) (2x), [bring up](#) (4x), [nurse](#) (2x), [be nursed](#) (1x), [surely be](#) (1x), [stand fast](#) (1x), [fail](#) (1x), [trusty](#) (1x).*

אִמְנָם H544 **umnam** *very, truly, indeed, [indeed](#) (3x), [very deed](#) (1x), [surety](#) (1x).*

From root: אָמַן H551 **amnam** *verily, truly, surely* [truth](#) (3x), [indeed](#) (2x), [true](#) (1x), [no doubt](#) (1x), [surely](#) (1x), [indeed](#) (1x).

From root: אָמַן H544 **omen** *faithfulness* [truth](#) (1x). Isaiah 25:1 "O LORD, thou *art* my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful *things*; thy counsels of old *are* faithfulness <sup>H530</sup> and truth." <sup>H544</sup> Google translate: *artist, fidelity, trust, confidence, belief, faith*

From root: אָמַן H539 **aman** (above) Google translate: *artist, amen, faithfulness, loyalty, train(verb: to train l'aman)*

אִמְנָם H552 **umnam** An orthographical variation of אָמַן(H551) (above) *very, truly, indeed, [indeed](#) (3x), [very deed](#) (1x), [surety](#) (1x).*

אָמֵן H543 **Amen**, *verily, truly, amen, so be it, [amen](#) (27x), [truly](#) (2x), [so be it](#) (1x).*
