

# GRACE

Gen 6:8 (KJV) But Noah found GRACE in the eyes of יְהוָה.

Gen. 19:19 (KJV) Behold now, thy servant hath found GRACE in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die :

Gen. 43:29 God be GRACIOUS to you, my son!

Ex 33:13 (KJV) Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found GRACE in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find GRACE in thy sight:

Ex. 33:16 (KJV) For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found GRACE in thy sight? is it not in that thou goest with us?

Ex. 33:16 (KJV) And יְהוָה said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that thou hast spoken : for thou hast found GRACE in my sight, and I know thee by name.

Ex. 33: 18-19 Moses said, "Show me your glory, I pray." 19 And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you, and will proclaim before you the name, יְהוָה; and I will be GRACIOUS to whom I will be GRACIOUS, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.

Ex. 34:6-7 יְהוָה passed before him, and proclaimed, "יְהוָה, יְהוָה, a God merciful and GRACIOUS, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, 7 keeping steadfast love for the thousandth generation, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, yet by no means clearing the guilty,

Ex. 34:9 (KJV) If now I have found GRACE in thy sight, O Adonai, let my Adonai, I pray thee, go among us;

Numbers 6:23-26 Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall bless the Israelites: You shall say to them, 24 יְהוָה bless you and keep you; 25 יְהוָה make his face to shine upon you, and be GRACIOUS to you; 26 יְהוָה lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace. 27 So they shall put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them.

2 Kings 13:23 But יְהוָה was GRACIOUS to them and had compassion on them;

2 Chron. 30:9 For as you return to יְהוָה, your kindred and your children will find compassion with their captors, and return to this land. For יְהוָה your God is GRACIOUS and merciful, and will not turn away his face from you, if you return to him.

Ezra 7:9 the GRACIOUS hand of his God was upon him.

Ezra 8:18 the GRACIOUS hand of our God was upon us,

Ezra 8:22 the hand of our God is GRACIOUS to all who seek him, but his power and his wrath are against all who forsake him.

Neh 2:8,18 the king granted me what I asked, for the GRACIOUS hand of my God was upon me. ... I told them that the hand of my God had been GRACIOUS upon me,

Neh 9:17,31 But you are a God ready to forgive, GRACIOUS and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and you did not forsake them. ... Nevertheless, in your great mercies you did not make an end of them or forsake them, for you are a GRACIOUS and merciful God.

Psalms 4:1 Answer me when I call, O God of my right! You gave me room when I was in distress. Be GRACIOUS to me, and hear my prayer.

Psalms 6:2 Be GRACIOUS to me, O יְהוָה, for I am languishing; O יְהוָה, heal me, for my bones are shaking with terror.

Psalms 9:13 Be GRACIOUS to me, O יְהוָה. See what I suffer from those who hate me; you are the one who lifts me up from the gates of death,

Psalms 25:16 Turn to me and be GRACIOUS to me, for I am lonely and afflicted.

Psalms 26:11 But as for me, I walk in my integrity; redeem me, and be GRACIOUS to me.

Psalms 45:2 (KJV) GRACE is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever.

Psalms 67:1 May God be GRACIOUS to us and bless us and make his face to shine upon us, (Selah)

Psalms 84:11 (KJV) For יְהוָה God is a sun and shield: יְהוָה will give GRACE and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Psalms 86:15 But you, O יְהוָה, are a God merciful and GRACIOUS, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

Psalms 103:8 יְהוָה is merciful and GRACIOUS, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

Psalms 116:5 GRACIOUS is יְהוָה, and righteous; our God is merciful.

Psalms 135:3 Praise יְהוָה, for יְהוָה is good; sing to his name, for he is GRACIOUS.

Psalms 145:8 יְהוָה is GRACIOUS and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

Psalms 145:13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations. יְהוָה is faithful in all his words, and GRACIOUS in all his deeds.

Psalms 147:1 Praise יְהוָה! How good it is to sing praises to our God; for he is GRACIOUS, and a song of praise is fitting.

Prov. 1:8-9 (KJV) My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: 9 For they shall be an ornament of GRACE unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

Prov. 3:21-22 (KJV) My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion: 22 So shall they be life unto thy soul, and GRACE to thy neck.

Prov. 3:34 (KJV) Surely he scorneth the scorners : but he giveth GRACE unto the lowly .

Prov. 4:7-9 (KJV) Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. 8 Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour , when thou dost embrace her. 9 She shall give to thine head an ornament of GRACE: a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee.

Prov. 22:11 (KJV) He that loveth pureness of heart, for the GRACE of his lips the king shall be his friend.

Isaiah 30:18 Therefore יְהוָה waits to be GRACIOUS to you; therefore he will rise up to show mercy to you. For יְהוָה is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him.

Isaiah 30:19 Truly, O people in Zion, inhabitants of Jerusalem, you shall weep no more. He will surely be GRACIOUS to you at the sound of your cry; when he hears it, he will answer you.

Isaiah 63:7 Truly, O people in Zion, inhabitants of Jerusalem, you shall weep no more. He will surely be GRACIOUS to you at the sound of your cry; when he hears it, he will answer you.

Jer. 31:2 Thus saith יְהוָה, The people which were left of the sword found GRACE in the wilderness; even Israel, when I went to cause him to rest.

Joel 2:12-14 Yet even now, says יְהוָה, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; 13 rend your hearts and not your clothing. Return to יְהוָה, your God, for he is GRACIOUS and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing. 14 Who knows whether he will not turn and relent, and leave a blessing behind him,

Amos 5:15 Hate evil and love good, and establish justice in the gate; it may be that יְהוָה, the God of hosts, will be GRACIOUS to the remnant of Joseph.

Jonah 4:2 You are a GRACIOUS God and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and ready to relent from punishing.

Zech. 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of GRACE and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced , and they shall mourn

Zech 4:7 What are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain; and he shall bring out the top stone amid shouts of "GRACE, GRACE to it! "

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of GRACE and truth.

John 1:16 From his fullness we have all received, GRACE upon GRACE.

John 1:17 The law indeed was given through Moses; GRACE and truth came through **ישוע** Messiah.

Luke 2:40 And the child grew , and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the GRACE of God was upon him.

Luke 4:22 All spoke well of him and were amazed at the GRACIOUS words that came from his mouth.

Matt. 11:25-26 At that time **ישוע** said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; 26 yes, Father, for such was your GRACIOUS will.

Luke 10:21 At that same hour **ישוע** rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your GRACIOUS will.

Acts 4:33 With great power the apostles gave their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord **ישוע** , and great GRACE was upon them all.

Acts 11:23 When he (Barnabas) came and saw the GRACE of God, he rejoiced, and he exhorted them (the Hellenist Jews) all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast devotion;

Acts 13:43 When the meeting of the synagogue broke up, many Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who spoke to them and urged them to continue in the GRACE of God.

Acts 14:3 So they remained for a long time, speaking boldly for the Lord, who testified to the word of his GRACE by granting signs and wonders to be done through them.

Acts 14:26 From there they sailed back to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work that they had completed.

Acts 15:11 On the contrary, we believe that we will be saved through the GRACE of the Lord **ישוע** , just as they will.

Acts 15:40 But Paul chose Silas and set out, the believers commending him to the GRACE of the Lord.

Acts 18:27 the believers encouraged him and wrote to the disciples to welcome him. On his arrival he greatly helped those who through GRACE had become believers,

Acts 20:24 But I do not count my life of any value to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord **ישוע** , to testify to the good news of God's GRACE.

Acts 20:32 And now I commend you to God and to the message of his GRACE, a message that is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all who are sanctified.

Romans 1:4-5 **ישוע** Messiah our Lord, 5 through whom we have received GRACE and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith among all the Gentiles for the sake of his name,

Romans 3:21-25 But now, apart from law, the righteousness of God has been disclosed, and is attested by the law and the prophets, 22 the righteousness of God through faith in **ישוע** Messiah for all who believe. For there is no distinction, 23 since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; 24 they are now justified by his GRACE as a gift, through the redemption that is in Messiah **ישוע** , 25 whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith. He did this to show his righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over the sins previously committed;

Romans 4:16 For this reason it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on GRACE and be guaranteed to all his descendants, not only to the adherents of the law but also to those who share the faith of Abraham ....

Romans 5:2 through whom we have obtained access to this GRACE in which we stand; and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God.

Romans 5:15 But ... the GRACE of God and the free gift in the GRACE of the one man, ישוע Messiah, abounded for the many.

Romans 5:17 much more surely will those who receive the abundance of GRACE and the free gift of righteousness exercise dominion in life through the one man, ישוע Messiah.

Romans 5:20 but where sin increased, GRACE abounded all the more,

Romans 5: 21 so GRACE might also exercise dominion through justification leading to eternal life through ישוע Messiah our Lord.

Romans 6:14 For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under GRACE.

Romans 11:5 So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by GRACE.

Romans 11:6 But if it is by GRACE, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise GRACE would no longer be GRACE.

Romans 12:6 We have gifts that differ according to the GRACE given to us.

Romans 16:20 The GRACE of our Lord ישוע Messiah be with you.

I Cor. 1:3-4 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah. I give thanks to my God always for you because of the GRACE of God that has been given you in Messiah ישוע,

I Cor. 3:10 According to the GRACE of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it.

I Cor. 15:10 But by the GRACE of God I am what I am, and his GRACE toward me has not been in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them—though it was not I, but the GRACE of God that is with me.

I Cor. 16:23 The GRACE of the Lord ישוע be with you.

2 Cor. 1:2 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah.

2 Cor 1:12 ... We have behaved in the world with frankness and Godly sincerity, not by earthly wisdom but by the GRACE of God ....

2 Cor. 3:1 We urge you also not to accept the GRACE of God in vain.

2 Cor. 1:8 We want you to know, brothers and sisters, about the GRACE of God that has been granted to the churches of Macedonia.

2 Cor. 9:14 the surpassing GRACE of God that he has given you.

2 Cor. 12:9 "My GRACE is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness."

2 Cor. 13:13 The GRACE of the Lord ישוע Messiah, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

Gal 1:3 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah,

Gal 1:6 the one who called you in the GRACE of Messiah

Gal 2:9 when James and Cephas and John, who were acknowledged pillars, recognized the GRACE that had been given to me, they gave to Barnabas and me the right hand of fellowship,

Gal 2:21 I do not nullify the GRACE of God; for if justification comes through the law, then Messiah died for nothing.

Gal 5:4 You who want to be justified by the law have cut yourselves off from Messiah; you have fallen away from GRACE.

Gal 6:18 May the GRACE of our Lord ישוע Messiah be with your spirit, brothers and sisters. Amen.

Eph. 1:2 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah.

Eph. 1:6 to the praise of his glorious GRACE that he freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

Eph. 1:7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his GRACE.

Eph. 2:5 by GRACE you have been saved—

Eph. 2:7 so that in the ages to come he might show the immeasurable riches of his GRACE in kindness toward us in Messiah ישוע.

- Eph. 2:8 For by GRACE you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—
- Eph. 3:2 for surely you have already heard of the commission of God's GRACE that was given me for you,
- Eph. 3:7 Of this gospel I have become a servant according to the gift of God's GRACE that was given me by the working of his power.
- Eph. 3:8 Although I am the very least of all the saints, this GRACE was given to me to bring to the Gentiles the news of the boundless riches of Messiah,
- Eph. 4:7 But each of us was given GRACE according to the measure of Messiah's gift.
- Eph. 4:29 Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up, as there is need, so that your words may give GRACE to those who hear.
- Eph. 6:24 GRACE be with all who have an undying love for our Lord ישוע Messiah.
- Phil. 1:2 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah.
- Phil. 1:7 for all of you share in God's GRACE with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel.
- Phil. 4:23 The GRACE of the Lord ישוע Messiah be with your spirit.
- Col. 1:2 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father.
- Col. 1:6 Just as it is bearing fruit and growing in the whole world, so it has been bearing fruit among yourselves from the day you heard it and truly comprehended the GRACE of God.
- Col. 4:18 GRACE be with you.
- I Thess. 1:1 GRACE to you and peace.
- I Thess. 5:28 The GRACE of our Lord ישוע Messiah be with you.
- 2 Thess. 1:2 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord ישוע Messiah.
- 2 Thess. 1:11-12 To this end we always pray for you, asking that our God will make you worthy of his call and will fulfill by his power every good resolve and work of faith, 12 so that the name of our Lord ישוע may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the GRACE of our God and the Lord ישוע Messiah.
- 2 Thess. 2:16 Now may our Lord ישוע Messiah himself and God our Father, who loved us and through GRACE gave us eternal comfort and good hope,
- 2 Thess. 3:18 The GRACE of our Lord ישוע Messiah be with all of you.
- I Tim. 1:2 To Timothy, my loyal child in the faith: GRACE, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Messiah ישוע our Lord.
- I Tim. 1:14 and the GRACE of our Lord overflowed for me with the faith and love that are in Messiah ישוע.
- I Tim. 6:21 GRACE be with you.
- 2 Tim. 1:2 To Timothy, my beloved child: GRACE, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Messiah ישוע our Lord.
- 2 Tim. 1:8-9 Do not be ashamed, then, of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner, but join with me in suffering for the gospel, relying on the power of God, 9 who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works but according to his own purpose and GRACE. This GRACE was given to us in Messiah ישוע before the ages began,
- 2 Tim. 2:1 You then, my child, be strong in the GRACE that is in Messiah ישוע;
- 2 Tim. 4:22 The Lord be with your spirit. GRACE be with you.
- Titus 1:4 To Titus, my loyal child in the faith we share: GRACE and peace from God the Father and Messiah ישוע our Savior.
- Titus 2:11 For the GRACE of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all,
- Titus 3:4-7 But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, 5 he saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but according to his mercy, through the water of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit. 6 This Spirit he poured out on us richly through ישוע Messiah our Savior, 7 so that, having been justified by his GRACE, we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
- Titus 3:15 GRACE be with all of you.

- Philemon 1:3,25 GRACE to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord **ישוע** Messiah. ... The GRACE of the Lord **ישוע** Messiah be with your spirit.
- Heb. 2:9 but we do see **ישוע**, who for a little while was made lower than the angels, now crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the GRACE of God he might taste death for everyone.
- Heb. 4:16 Let us therefore approach the throne of GRACE with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find GRACE to help in time of need.
- Heb. 10:29 How much worse punishment do you think will be deserved by those who have spurned the Son of God, profaned the blood of the covenant by which they were sanctified, and outraged the Spirit of GRACE?
- Heb. 12:15 See to it that no one fails to obtain the GRACE of God; that no root of bitterness springs up and causes trouble, and through it many become defiled.
- Heb. 13:9 Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings; for it is well for the heart to be strengthened by GRACE, not by regulations about food, which have not benefited those who observe them.
- Heb. 13:25 GRACE be with all of you.
- James 4:6 But he gives all the more GRACE; therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives GRACE to the humble."
- I Pet. 1:1-2 To the exiles of the Dispersion ... 2 who have been chosen and destined by God the Father and sanctified by the Spirit to be obedient to **ישוע** Messiah and to be sprinkled with his blood: May GRACE and peace be yours in abundance.
- I Pet. 1:2 Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the GRACE that was to be yours made careful search and inquiry,
- I Pet. 1:13 Therefore prepare your minds for action; discipline yourselves; set all your hope on the GRACE that **ישוע** Messiah will bring you when he is revealed.
- I Pet. 3:7 Husbands, in the same way, show consideration for your wives in your life together, paying honor to the woman as the weaker sex, since they too are also heirs of the GRACIOUS gift of life—so that nothing may hinder your prayers.
- I Pet. 4:10 Like good stewards of the manifold GRACE of God, serve one another with whatever gift each of you has received.
- I Pet. 5:5 In the same way, you who are younger must accept the authority of the elders. And all of you must clothe yourselves with humility in your dealings with one another, for "God opposes the proud, but gives GRACE to the humble."
- I Pet. 5:10 And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all GRACE, who has called you to his eternal glory in Messiah, will himself restore, support, strengthen, and establish you.
- I Pet. 5:12 I have written this short letter to encourage you and to testify that this is the true GRACE of God. Stand fast in it.
- 2 Pet. 1:2 May GRACE and peace be yours in abundance in the knowledge of God and of **ישוע** our Lord.
- 2 Pet. 3:8 But grow in the GRACE and knowledge of our Lord and Savior **ישוע** Messiah. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.
- 2 John 1:3 GRACE, mercy, and peace will be with us from God the Father and from **ישוע** Messiah, the Father's Son, in truth and love.
- Jude 1:4 For certain intruders have stolen in among you, people who long ago were designated for this condemnation as ungodly, who pervert the GRACE of our God into licentiousness and deny our only Master and Lord, **ישוע** Messiah.
- Rev. 1:4 GRACE to you and peace from him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before his throne,
- Rev. 22:21 The GRACE of the Lord **ישוע** be with all the saints. Amen
