NEW COVENANT STANDING PRAYER

The pronouns of the original Scriptures (NRSV) have been changed and/or capitalized. YESHUA MESSIAH is used instead of JESUS CHRIST; YHVH instead of GOD most of the time; important words capitalized, like Gospel, Name, etc., some words replaced in brackets.

[Thank you, Father, that You have] called [me and] ... set [me] apart for [Your] Gospel ... 2 which [You] promised beforehand through [Your] prophets in the Holy Scriptures, 3 the Gospel concerning [Your] Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh 4 and was declared to be Son of YHVH with power according to the Spirit of holiness by resurrection from the dead, Yeshua Messiah our Lord,5 through whom [I] have received grace ... to bring about the obedience of faith among ... [unbelievers] for the sake of [Your] Name, (Rom. 1:1-5)

Long ago [You] spoke to our ancestors in many and various ways by the prophets, 2 but in these last days [You have] spoken to us by [Your] Son, whom [You] appointed heir of all things, through whom [You] also created the worlds. 3 He is the reflection of [Your] glory and the exact imprint of [Your] very being, and He sustains all things by [Your] powerful Word. When He had made purification for sins, He sat down at [Your] right hand [O] Majesty on high, 4 having become as much superior to angels as the Name He has inherited is more excellent than theirs. (Heb. 1:1-4)

Blessed [are You,] YHVH and Father of our Lord Yeshua Messiah! By [Your] great mercy [You have] given [me] a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Yeshua Messiah from the dead, 4 and into an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for [me], 5 [I am] being protected by [Your] power ... through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 In this [I] rejoice, even if now for a little while [I] have had to suffer various trials, 7 so that the genuineness of [my] faith—being more precious than gold that, though perishable, is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor when [You,] Yeshua Messiah. [are] revealed. (I Pet. 1:3-7)

...[Thank You, Father, for giving me] a faith [so] precious ... through [Your] righteousness [O] YHVH and Savior Yeshua Messiah: 2 May grace and peace [shalom be [mine] in abundance in the knowledge of [You,] YHVH and ... Yeshua our Lord. 3 [Your] divine power has given [me] everything needed for life and Godliness, through the knowledge of [You] who called [me] by [Your] own glory and goodness. 4 Thus [You have] given [me], through these things, [Your] precious and very great promises, so that through them [I] may escape from the corruption that is in the world because of lust, and may become [a] participant of [Your] divine nature. 5 For this very reason, [help me to] make every effort to support [my] faith with goodness, and goodness with knowledge, 6 and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with endurance, and endurance with Godliness, 7 and Godliness with mutual affection, and mutual affection with love. (2 Pet. 1:1-7)

[Fill me with Your] Grace ... and peace [shalom], [O] YHVH our Father, and ... [Adonai] Yeshua Messiah. 4 I thank [You] always [concerning Your] grace ... which [You have] given [me] in Messiah Yeshua; that [I am] enriched in everything by [You] in all utterance and all knowledge, 6 even as the testimony of Messiah was confirmed in [me], 7 so that [I] come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Yeshua Messiah, 8 who will also confirm [me] to the end, that [I] may be blameless in the day of our Lord Yeshua Messiah. 9 [You are] faithful, by whom [I was] called into the fellowship of [Your] Son, Yeshua Messiah our Lord.. (I Cor. 1:3-9 NKJV)

Blessed [are You,] YHVH and Father of our Lord Yeshua Messiah, the Father of mercies and the God of all consolation, 4 who consoles [me] in all [my] affliction, so that [I] may be able to console those who are in any affliction with the consolation with which [I am] consoled by YHVH. 5 For just as the sufferings of Messiah are abundant for [me], so also [my] consolation is abundant through Messiah. (2 Cor. 1:3-5)

[Keep me filled to overflowing with Your] Grace ... and peace [shalom] [O] YHVH our Father and [Adonai] Yeshua Messiah, 4 who gave [Yourself] for [my] sins to set [me] free from the present evil age, according [Your] will [O] YHVH and Father, 5 to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen. (Gal. 1:3-5)

Blessed [are You,] YHVH and Father of our Lord Yeshua Messiah, who has blessed [me] in Messiah with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 just as [You] chose [me] in Messiah before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before [You] in love. 5 [You] destined [me] for adoption as [Your child] through Yeshua Messiah, according to the good pleasure of [Your] will, 6 to the praise of [Your] glorious grace that [You] freely bestowed on [me] in the Beloved. 7 In [You] [I] have redemption through the Blood, the forgiveness of [my] trespasses, according to the riches of [Your] grace 8 that [You] lavished on [me]. With all wisdom and insight 9 [You are making] known to [me] the mystery of [Your] will, according to [Your] good pleasure that [You] set forth in Messiah, 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to gather up all things in Him, things in heaven and things on earth. 11 In Messiah [I] have also obtained an inheritance, having been destined according to the purpose of [You] who accomplishes all things according to [Your] counsel and will, 12 so that [I], who [have] set [my] hope on Messiah, might live for the praise of [Your] glory. 13 In [You] [I] also, when [I] heard the Word of Truth, the Gospel of Your Salvation, and believed in [You], [was] marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit; 14 this is the pledge of our inheritance toward redemption as [Your] own people, to the praise of [Your] glory. 15 ... [F]or this reason 16 I do not cease to give thanks ... in my prayers. 17 I pray that [You,] God of our Lord Yeshua Messiah, the Father of glory, may give [me] a spirit of wisdom and revelation as [I] come to know [You], 18 so that, with the eyes of [my] heart enlightened, [I] may know what is the hope to which [You have] called [me], what are the riches of [Your] glorious inheritance among the [redeemed], 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of [Your] power for us who believe, according to the working of [Your] great power. 20 [You] put this power to work in Messiah when [You] raised Him from the dead and seated Him at [Your] right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the age to come. 22 And [You have] put all things under His feet and [have] made Him the head over all things for the [congregations], 23 which [are Your] body, the fullness of [You] who fills all in all. (Eph. 1:3 to end)

But [You,] YHVH, [so] rich in mercy, out of [Your] great love with which [You] loved [me] 5 even when [I was] dead through [my] trespasses, made [me] alive together with Messiah —by grace [I] have been saved— 6 and raised [me] up with Him and seated [me] with Him in the heavenly places in Messiah Yeshua, 7 so that in the ages to come [You] might show the immeasurable riches of [Your] grace in kindness toward [me] in Messiah Yeshua. 8 For by grace [I] have been saved through faith, and this is not [my] own doing; it is [Your] gift [O] YHVH— 9 not the result of works, so that [I] may [not] boast. 10 For [I am] what [You have] made [me], created in Messiah Yeshua for good works, which [You] prepared beforehand to be [my] way of life. (Eph. 2:4-10)

So if [I] have been raised with Messiah, [help me to] seek the things that are above, where Messiah is, seated at [Your] right hand, [O] YHVH. 2 [Help me to] Set [my] mind on things that are above, not on things that are on earth, 3 for [I] have died, and [my] life is hidden with Messiah in [You,] YHVH. 4 When Messiah who is [my] life is revealed, then [I] also will be revealed with Him in glory. 5 [Help me to] Put to death, therefore, whatever in [me] is earthly: fornication, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed (which is idolatry). (Col 3:1-5)

Let the same mind be in [me] that was in [You,] Messiah Yeshua, 6 who, though [You were] in the form of YHVH, did not regard equality with YHVH as something to be exploited, 7 but emptied [Yourself], taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, 8 [You] humbled [Yourself] and became obedient to the point of death— even death on a cross. 9 Therefore YHVH also highly exalted [You] and gave [You] the Name that is above every name, 10 so that at the Name of Yeshua every knee [shall bow], in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue [shall] confess that Yeshua Messiah is Lord, to the glory of YHVH the Father. (Phil 2:5-11)

Of this Gospel I have become a servant according to the gift of [Your] grace that was given me by the working of [Your] power. 8 Although I am the very least of all the [redeemed], this grace was given to me to bring to [unbelievers] the news of the boundless riches of Messiah, 9 and to make everyone see what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in [You,] YHVH, who created all things; 10 so that through the [congregations] [Your manifold (KJV)] wisdom [O] YHVH in its rich variety might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. 11 This was in accordance with [Your] eternal purpose that [You have] carried out in Messiah Yeshua our Lord, 12 in whom [I] have access to [You,] YHVH, in boldness and confidence through faith.... 13 I pray therefore that [I] may not lose heart over my sufferings [for the Gospel]; they are [for Your] glory. Eph. 3:7-13

For this reason I bow my knees before [You,] Father, 15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth takes its name. 16 I pray that, according to the riches of [Your] glory, [You] may grant that [I] may be strengthened in [my] inner being with power through [Your] Spirit, 17 and that Messiah may dwell in [my] heart through faith, as [I am] being rooted and grounded in love. 18 I pray that [I] may have the power to comprehend, with all the [redeemed], what is the breadth and length and height and depth, 19 and to know the love of Messiah that surpasses knowledge, so that [I] may be filled with all [Your] fullness [O] YHVH. 20 Now to [You] who by the power at work within [me] is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all [I] can ask or imagine, 21 to [You] be glory in the [congregations] and in Messiah Yeshua to all generations, forever and ever. Amen. (Eph. 3:14 to end)

I thank [You,] YHVH ..., 4 constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers..., 5 because of [my] sharing in [Your] Gospel from the first day until now. 6 I am confident of this, that [You] who began a good work [in me] will bring it to completion by the day of Yeshua Messiah. ... 8 ... 9 And this is my prayer, that [my] love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight 10 to help [me] to determine what is best, so that in the day of Messiah [I] may be pure and blameless, 11 having produced the harvest of righteousness that comes through Yeshua Messiah for the glory and praise of [You,] YHVH. (Phil. 1:3-11)

For this reason, since the day [I] heard it, [I] have not ceased praying ... and asking that [I] may be filled with the knowledge of [Your] will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, 10 so that [I] may lead [a life] worthy of [You], fully pleasing to [You], as [I] bear fruit in every good work and as [I] grow in the knowledge of [You,] YHVH. 11 May [I] be made strong with all the strength that comes from [Your] glorious power, and may [I] be prepared to endure everything with patience, while joyfully 12 giving thanks to [You,] Father, who has enabled [me] to share in the inheritance of the [redeemed] in the Light. 13 [You have] rescued [me] from the power of darkness and transferred [me] into the Kingdom of [Your] beloved Son, 14 in whom [I] have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. 15 [Yeshua, You are] the image of the invisible YHVH, the firstborn of all creation; 16 for in [You] all things in heaven and on earth were created, things visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or powers—all things have been created through [You] and for [You]. 17 [You] [Yourself are] before all things, and in [You] all things hold together. 18 [You are] the head of the body, the [congregations]; [You are] the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that [You] might come to have first place in everything. 19 For in [You] all the fullness of YHVH was pleased to dwell, 20 and through [You] YHVH was pleased to reconcile to [Yourself] all things, whether on earth or in heaven, by making peace through the blood of [Your] cross. 21 And [I] who [was] once estranged and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds, 22 [You have] now reconciled in [Your] fleshly body through death, so as to present [me] holy and blameless and irreproachable before [You] — 23 provided that [I] [Help me, Father.] continue securely established and steadfast in the faith, without shifting from the hope promised by the Gospel that [I] heard, which has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven. [Help me, Father, to be a good] servant of this Gospel. (Col. 1:9-23)
