## THAT IT MAY GO WELL WITH YOU

- Exodus 20:12 Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.
- Eph. 6:2-3 "Honor your father and mother"—this is the first commandment with a promise: 3 "so that it **may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.**"
- Deut. 4:40 Keep His statutes and His commandments, which I am commanding you today **for your own well-being** and that of your descendants after you, so **that you may long remain** in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for all time.
- Deut. 5:16 Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God commanded you, so that **your days may be long** and that it **may go well** with you in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.
- Deut. 5:33 You must follow exactly the path that the Lord your God has commanded you, **so that you may live**, and that it **may go well** with you, and that **you may live long** in the land that you are to possess.
- Deut. 5:29 If only they had such a mind as this, to fear Me and to keep all My commandments always, so that it might go well with them and with their children forever!
- Deut. 6:2 Now this is the commandment—the statutes and the ordinances—that the Lord your God charged me to teach you to observe in the land that you are about to cross into and occupy, **2** so that you and your children and your children may fear the Lord your God all the days of your life, and keep all his decrees and his commandments that I am commanding you, **so that your days may be long**.
- Deut. 6:3 Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe them diligently, so that it **may go well** with you, and so that you may multiply greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, as the Lord, the God of your ancestors, has promised you.
- Deut. 6:18 Do what is right and good in the sight of the Lord, so that it **may go well** with you, and so that you may go in and occupy the good land that the Lord swore to your ancestors to give you,
- Deut. 6:24 Then the Lord commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the Lord our God, **for our lasting good**, so as **to keep us alive**, as is now the case.
- Deut. 7:12-13 If you heed these ordinances, by diligently observing them, the Lord your God will maintain with you the covenant loyalty that he swore to your ancestors; 13 He will love you, bless you, and multiply you; He will bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground, your grain and your wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the issue of your flock, in the land that he swore to your ancestors to give you.
- Deut. 8:1-3 This entire commandment that I command you today you must diligently observe, so that **you may live** and increase, and go in and occupy the land that the Lord promised on oath to your ancestors. 2

  Remember the long way that the Lord your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, in order to humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commandments. 3 He humbled you by letting you hunger, then by feeding you with manna, with which neither you nor your ancestors were acquainted, in order to make you understand that one does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.
- Deut. 9:5 It is **not** because of your righteousness or the uprightness of your heart that you are going in to occupy their land; but because of the wickedness of these nations the Lord your God is dispossessing them before
- Deut. 9:6-7 Know, then, that the Lord your God is **not** giving you this good land to occupy because of your righteousness; for you are a stubborn people. **7** Remember and do not forget how you provoked the Lord your God to wrath in the wilderness; you have been rebellious against the Lord from the day you came out of the land of Egypt until you came to this place.
- Deut. 10:13 and to keep the commandments of the Lord your God and his decrees that I am commanding you today, for your own well-being.
- Deut. 11:8-9 Keep, then, this entire commandment that I am commanding you today, **so that you may have**strength to go in and occupy the land that you are crossing over to occupy, **9** and **so that you may live**long in the land that the Lord swore to your ancestors to give them and to their descendants, a land flowing with milk and honey.
- Deut. 11:18, 20-21 You shall put these words of mine in your heart and soul, ... 20 Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, 21 so that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land that the Lord swore to your ancestors to give them, as long as the heavens are above the earth.

- Deut. 12:23-25 Only be sure that you do not eat the blood; for the blood is the life, and you shall not eat the life with the meat. 24 Do not eat it; you shall pour it out on the ground like water. Do not eat it, so that all **may go well** with you and your children after you, because you do what is right in the sight of the Lord.
- Deut. 12:28 Be careful to obey all these words that I command you today, so that it **may go well** with you and with your children after you forever, because you will be doing what is good and right in the sight of the Lord your God.
- Deut. 16:20 Justice, and only justice, you shall pursue, so **that you may live** and occupy the land that the Lord your God is giving you.
- Deut. 19:13 Show no pity; you shall purge the guilt of innocent blood from Israel, so that it may go well with you.
- Deut. 29:9 Therefore diligently observe the words of this covenant, in order that you may succeed in everything that you do.
- Deut. 30:19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today that I have set before you **life** and death, blessings and curses. **Choose life** so that you and your descendants **may live**, **20** loving the Lord your God, obeying him, and holding fast to him; for that means life to you and length of days,
- Deut. 31:46-47 Take to heart all the words that I am giving ...you today; give them as a command to your children, so that they may diligently observe all the words of this law. **This is no trifling matter** for you, but rather **your very life**; through it **you may live long** in the land ....
- Matt. 6:31, Therefore do not worry, saying, "What will we eat?" or "What will we drink?" or "What will we wear?" ... indeed your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. 33 But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- Matt. 11:28 Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.
- III John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, just as it is well with your soul.
