What שוש (Yeshua) Says About the Law and His Commandments

His Commandments

Matt. 5:17-20 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish <u>but to fulfill</u>. 18 For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter, not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished. 19 Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. 20 For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matt. 5:21-22 "You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, "You shall not murder'; and "whoever murders shall be liable to judgment.' 22 <u>But I say</u> to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, "You fool,' you will be liable to the hell of fire.

Matt. 5:27-28 "You have heard that it was said, "You shall not commit adultery.' 28 <u>But I say</u> to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Matt. 5:31 "It was also said, "Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' 32 <u>But I say</u> to you that anyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of unchastity, causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

Matt. 19:7-12 They said to him, "Why then did Moses command us to give a certificate of dismissal and to divorce her?" 8 He said to them, "It was because you were so hard-hearted that Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. 9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for unchastity, and marries another commits adultery." 10 His disciples said to him, "If such is the case of a man with his wife, it is better not to marry." 11 But he said to them, "Not everyone can accept this teaching, but only those to whom it is given. 12 For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth, and there are eunuchs who have been made eunuchs by others, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. Let anyone accept this who can."

Matt. 5:33-34 "Again, you have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, "You shall not swear falsely, but carry out the vows you have made to the Lord.' 34 <u>But I say</u> to you, Do not swear at all,

Matt. 5:38 "You have heard that it was said, "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.' 39 <u>But I say</u> to you, Do not resist an evildoer.

Matt. 5:43 "You have heard that it was said, "You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 <u>But I say</u> to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

Luke 6:27-28, 35 Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, 28 bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you. ... 35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return. Your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High; for he is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked.

Luke 6: 29-30 and from anyone who takes away your coat do not withhold even your shirt. Give to everyone who begs from you; and if anyone takes away your goods, do not ask for them again.

Matt. 5:25 Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are on the way to court with him,

Matt. 6:1,3 "Beware of practicing your piety before others in order to be seen by them; for then you have no reward from your Father in heaven. ... 3 But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, 4 so that your alms may be done in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

Matt. 6: 5-6 "And whenever you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. ... 6 But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. 7 "When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases

Matt. 6:16-17 "And whenever you fast, do not look dismal, ... 17 But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, 18 so that your fasting may be seen not by others....

Matt. 5:16 ... let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

Luke 12:1b-2 "Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees, that is, their hypocrisy. 2 Nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known. 3 Therefore whatever you have said in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have whispered behind closed doors will be proclaimed from the housetops.

Matt. 5:20 For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Luke 12:15 "Take care! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; for one's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions."

Matt. 6:19-21 "Do not store up for yourselves <u>treasures</u> on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal; 20 but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. 21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Luke 12:20-21 But God said to him, "You fool! This very night your life is being demanded of you. And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' 21 So it is with those who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich toward God."

Luke 14:12-14 "When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or rich neighbors, in case they may invite you in return, and you would be repaid. 13 But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. 14 And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you, for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

Luke14:33 So therefore, none of you can become my disciple if you do not give up all your possessions.

Matt. 6:25-34 "Therefore I tell you, <u>do not worry</u> about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? 31 Therefore do not worry, ... 33 But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. 34 "So do not worry about tomorrow,

Luke 12:22 <u>do not worry</u> about your life, what you will eat, or about your body, what you will wear. 23 For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing. ... 29 And do not keep striving for what you are to eat and what you are to drink, and do not keep worrying. 31 Instead, strive for his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well. 32 "Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. 33 <u>Sell your possessions</u>, and give alms. Make purses for yourselves that do not wear out, an unfailing treasure in heaven 34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Luke 10:41 But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things; 42 there is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her."

Luke 21:34-36 "Be on guard so that your hearts are not weighed down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of this life, and that day does not catch you unexpectedly, 35 like a trap. For it will come upon all who live on the face of the whole earth. 36 Be alert at all times, praying that you may have the strength to escape all these things that will take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."

John 6:27, 29 Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. ... "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."

Luke 12:4 ... do not fear those who kill the body, and after that can do nothing more.

Luke 12:11-12 ... do not worry about how you are to defend yourselves or what you are to say; 12 for the Holy Spirit will teach you at that very hour what you ought to say."

Matt. 7:1 "Do not judge, so that you may not be judged. 2 For with the judgment you make you will be judged, ...

Luke 6:37 "Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven; ... 41 Why do you see the speck in your neighbor's eye, but do not notice the log in your own eye?

Matt. 7: 6 "Do not give what is holy to dogs; and do not throw your pearls before swine, ...

John 13:34 I give you a new commandment, that you <u>love one another</u>. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another.

Matt: 5:3-10 "<u>Blessed</u> are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 "<u>Blessed</u> are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. 5 "<u>Blessed</u> are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. 6 "<u>Blessed</u> are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. 7 "<u>Blessed</u> are the merciful, for they will receive mercy. 8 "<u>Blessed</u> are the pure in heart, for they will see God. 9 "<u>Blessed</u> are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. 10 "<u>Blessed</u> are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Luke 6:20-26 Then he looked up at his disciples and said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. 21 "Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you will be filled. "Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh. 22 "Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you on account of the Son of Man. 23 Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, for surely your reward is great in heaven; for that is what their ancestors did to the prophets. 24 "But woe to you who are rich, for you have received your consolation. 25 "Woe to you who are full now, for you will be hungry. "Woe to you who are laughing now, for you will mourn and weep. 26 "Woe to you when all speak well of you, for that is what their ancestors did to the false prophets.

Matt. 8: 10-12 When "Truly I tell you, in no one in Israel have I found such faith. 11 I tell you, <u>many will come from east and west and will eat with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven, 12 while the heirs of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."</u>

Matt 7:12-16 "In everything do to others as you would have them do to you; <u>for this is the law and the prophets</u>. 13 "Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the road is easy that leads to destruction, and there are many who take it. 14 For the gate is narrow and the road is hard that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Luke 13:24 "Strive to enter through the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able. ...

Matt. 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. 16 You will know them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thorns, or figs from thistles?

Luke 6:43-45 "No good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit; 44 for each tree is known by its own fruit. Figs are not gathered from thorns, nor are grapes picked from a bramble bush. 45 The good person out of the good treasure of the heart produces good, and the evil person out of evil treasure produces evil; for it is out of the abundance of the heart that the mouth speaks.

Matt 7:19-23 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. 20 Thus you will know them by their fruits. 21 "Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven. 22 On that day many will say to me, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many deeds of power in your name?" 23 Then I will declare to them, "I never knew you; go away from me, you evildoers."

Matt. 17:15-16 "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly; he often falls into the fire and often into the water. 16 And I brought him to your disciples, but they could not cure him." 17 מוני answered, "You faithless and perverse generation, how much longer must I be with you? How much longer must I put up with you? ..." ... "Why could we not cast it out?" 20 He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly I tell you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, "Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."

Luke 9:40-42 I begged your disciples to cast it out, but they could not." 41 איני answered, "You faithless and perverse generation, how much longer must I be with you and bear with you? Bring your son here."

Luke 10:19 See, I have given you authority to tread on snakes and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing will hurt you. 20 Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." 21 At that same hour שוע rejoiced in the Holy Spirit.

Sabbath

Matt. 12:1-8 At that time ""went through the grainfields on the <u>sabbath</u>; his disciples were hungry, and they began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. When the Pharisees saw it, they said to him, "Look, your disciples are doing what is not lawful to do on the sabbath." 3 He said to them, "Have you not read what David did when he and his companions were hungry? 4 He entered the house of God and ate the bread of the Presence, which it was not lawful for him or his companions to eat, but only for the priests. 5 Or have you not read in the law that on the sabbath the priests in the temple break the sabbath and yet are guiltless? 6 I tell you, something greater than the temple is here. 7 But if you had known what this means, "I desire mercy and not sacrifice,' you would not have condemned the guiltless. 8 For the Son of Man is lord of the sabbath." (Also Luke 6:1-5)

Luke 6:9-11 Then שונש said to them, "I ask you, is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the <u>sabbath</u>, to save life or to destroy it?" 10 After looking around at all of them, he said to him, "Stretch out your hand." He did so, and his hand was restored. 11 But they were filled with fury and discussed with one another what they might do to "שונש."

Matt. 12: 10-12 ... they asked him, "Is it lawful to cure on the <u>sabbath?"</u> so that they might accuse him. 11 He said to them, "Suppose one of you has only one sheep and it falls into a pit on the sabbath; will you not lay hold of it and lift it out? 12 How much more valuable is a human being than a sheep! So it is lawful to do good on the sabbath."

Luke 13:15, 16 "You hypocrites! ... 16 And ought not this woman, a daughter of Abraham whom Satan bound for eighteen long years, be set free from this bondage on the <u>sabbath</u> day?"

Matt 24:20 Pray that your flight may not be in winter or on a sabbath.

John 2:16 Stop making my Father's house a marketplace.

Yeshua and his parents kept Torah

Luke 2:21 After eight days had passed, it was time to circumcise the child; and he was called "", the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. 22 When the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord 23 (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male shall be designated as holy to the Lord"), 24 and they offered a sacrifice according to what is stated in the law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons."

Luke 2:39 When they had finished everything required by the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth.

Luke 2:41 Now every year his parents went to Jerusalem for the festival of the Passover.

John 2:13 The Passover of the Jews was near, and שונש went up to Jerusalem.

John 7:2 Now the Jewish festival of Booths was near. 3 So his brothers said to him, "Leave here and go to Judea so that your disciples also may see the works you are doing; ... 10 But after his brothers had gone to the festival, then he also went, not publicly but as it were in secret.

Luke 4:15 He began to teach in their synagogues and was praised by everyone. 16 When he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, he went to the synagogue on the sabbath day, as was his custom. He stood up to read,"

Love The Lord Your God With All Your Heart

Deuteronomy 6:5 NRS

You shall <u>love 'Thir'</u> your God <u>with all your heart</u>, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

Deuteronomy 10:12 NRS

So now, O Israel, what does להוד your God require of you? Only to fear יהוד your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve און your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ...

Deuteronomy 11:13 KJV

13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love $\overline{n}\overline{n}$ your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul, 14 That I will give you the rain of your land in his due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil. 15 And I will send grass in thy fields for thy cattle, that thou mayest eat and be full . 16 Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived

Deuteronomy 11:22 KJV

For if ye shall diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him;

Deuteronomy 13:3 NRS

you must not heed the words of those prophets or those who divine by dreams; for איז your God is testing you, to know whether you indeed love איז your God with all your heart and soul.

Deuteronomy 30:6 NRS

Moreover, הוה your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, so that you will love יהוה your God with all your heart and with all your soul, in order that you may live.

Joshua 22:5 NRS

Take good care to observe the commandment and instruction that Moses the servant of הוה commanded you, to love your God, to walk in all his ways, to keep his commandments, and to hold fast to him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Joshua 23:11 KJV

Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love in your God.

Matthew 22:36-40 "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?" 37 He said to him, " "You shall love 'הוֹה your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the greatest and first commandment. 39 And a second is like it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets."

Mark 12:28-31 ... he asked him, "Which commandment is the first of all?" 29 מוצי answered, "The first is, "Hear, O Israel: הוה our God, הוה is one; 30 you shall love <u>הוה</u> your God <u>with all your heart</u>, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' 31 The second is this, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' <u>There is no other commandment greater than these</u>."

Luke 10:25-28, 36-37 Just then a lawyer stood up to test מולי. "Teacher," he said, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" 26 He said to him, "What is written in the law? What do you read there?" 27 He answered, "You shall love ווהף?" your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." 28 And he said to him, "You have given the right answer; do this, and you will live." (Then he tells the Good Samaritan story where the priest and levite passed by the wounded man.) 36 Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?" 37 He said, "The one who showed him mercy." מולי said to him, "Go and do likewise."

Forgiveness

Matt. 12:31 Therefore I tell you, people will be forgiven for every sin and blasphemy, but

Matt. 12:36-37 I tell you, on the day of judgment you will have to give an account for every careless word you utter; 37 for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

Matt. 15: 1- 3, 6-11, 18 Then Pharisees and scribes came to "Tom Jerusalem and said, 2 "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands before they eat." 3 He answered them, "And why do you break the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition? ... 6 So, for the sake of your tradition, you make void the word of God. 7 You hypocrites! Isaiah prophesied rightly about you when he said: 8 "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; 9 in vain do they worship me, teaching human precepts as doctrines.' "10 Then he called the crowd to him and said to them, "Listen and understand: 11 it is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but it is what comes out of the mouth that defiles." ... 18 ... what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this is what defiles.

Matt. 16: 18-19 on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it. 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Matt. 18:15- 21 "If another member of the church sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the member listens to you, you have regained that one. ... 17 If the member refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if the offender refuses to listen even to the church, let such a one be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. 18 Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. 19 Again, truly I tell you, if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. 20 For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them." 21 Then Peter came and said to him, "Lord, if another member of the church sins against me, how often should I forgive? As many as seven times?" 22

John 20:21-23 "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." ... "Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 <u>If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."</u>

Luke 17:3-4 Be on your guard! If another disciple sins, you must rebuke the offender, and if there is repentance, you must forgive. 4 And if the same person sins against you seven times a day, and turns back to you seven times and says, "I repent,' you must <u>forgive."</u>

Matt. 6:14 For if you <u>forgive</u> others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you; 15 but if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Luke 6:37b Forgive, and you will be forgiven;

Matthew 9:12-13 But when he heard this, he said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. 13 Go and learn what this means, "I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have come to call not the righteous but sinners."

Luke 6:36 Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

Luke 5:31-32 שולש answered, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick; 32 I have come to call not the righteous but sinners to repentance."

More of His Commandments

Matt. 19:16-21 ... "... what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?" ... "If you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments." 18 He said to him, "Which ones?" And אוני said, "You shall not murder; You shall not commit adultery; You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; 19 Honor your father and mother; also, You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ... 21 אוני said to him, "If you wish to be perfect, go, sell your possessions, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me."

Matt. 21: 31-32 שוש said to them, "Truly I tell you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes are going into the kingdom of God ahead of you. 32 For John came to you in the way of righteousness and you did not believe him, but the tax collectors and the prostitutes believed him; and even after you saw it, you did not change your minds and believe him.

John 6:27-29 Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. ..." 28 Then they said to him, "What must we do to perform the works of God?" 29 מולע answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."

Matt. 21:43 Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people that produces the fruits of the kingdom.

Luke 13:26-28 Then you will begin to say, "We ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets.' 27 But he will say, "I do not know where you come from; go away from me, all you evildoers!' 28 There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrown out. 29 Then people will come from east and west, from north and south, and will eat in the kingdom of God.

Matt. 23:2-5, 13, 23 "The scribes and the Pharisees sit on Moses' seat; 3 therefore, do whatever they teach you and follow it; but do not do as they do, for they do not practice what they teach. 4 They tie up heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on the shoulders of others; ... 5 They do all their deeds to be seen by others; for they make their phylacteries broad and their fringes long. ...13 But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, https://pxyc.ncb/hypocrites! For you lock people out of the kingdom of heaven. For you do not go in yourselves, and when others are going in, you stop them. ... 23 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint, dill, and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. It is these you ought to have practiced without neglecting the others.

John 3:7 ... You must be born from above.

John 5:14 "See you have been made well! Do not sin anymore so that nothing worse happens to you."

John 6:53 So שוש" said to them, "Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his <u>blood</u>, you have no life in you. 54 Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day; 55 for my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink. 56 Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood abide in me, and I in them.

John 14:15 If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

Luke 6:46 "Why do you call me "Lord, Lord," and do not do what I tell you?

John 15:3, 5, 7 Abide in me as I abide in you. ... 5 ... Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit ... 7 If you abide in Me and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ... that you bear much fruit.

John 15:12 This is my commandment that you <u>love one another as I have loved you</u>. ... 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you. (Yeshua died for us while we were filthy sinners.)

John 13:14-15 So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to <u>wash one another's feet</u>. 15 For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you.

Luke 14:26-27 "Whoever comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and even life itself, cannot be my disciple. 27 Whoever does not carry the cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

See the two verses just above about loving and washing feet. Matt. 22:39 And a second is like it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself. Matt. 5:43 "You have heard that it was said, "You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I say to you, Love your enemies
